| English | <p>Reading: Core Reading Scheme Oxford Reading Tree Phonics Programme: Letters and Sounds, Phase 5, representing phonemes with different graphemes. Class reading book: selection of fiction and non-fiction relating to dinosaurs</p> <p>SPaG: using the suffixes -ing, -er and -est; use exclamation marks and question marks to punctuate sentences differently.</p> <p>Writing: write their own dinosaur poem; using information books and media to create a fact file and understand how to write the beginning, middle and ending of their own adventure story. Learning to recite poems.</p> |
| Mathematics | <p>Understanding division as sharing practically as well as using arrays. Recognising, naming and sorting 2D and 3D shapes. Continue to add and subtract mentally. Solving one step problems involving all four operations.</p> |
| Science | Plants and animals. Seasonal change (summer) |
| Computing | Programming a floor robot; stop frame animation. |
| History | Events beyond living memory; significant individuals – Mary Anning |
| Geography | Locating continents and oceans |
| Art and Design | Large and small-scale modelling; Papier Mache make a dinosaur egg. |
| Design Technology | Not covered this half term. |
| Physical Education | Gymnastics – Rocking and rolling Athletics – throwing, catching and jumping |
| PSHE | Sun Safety |
| Music | Investigating timbre, temp and dynamics. Rain compositions. Songs in conjunction with topic. |


Catechism of the Catholic Church

They will learn that Jesus responded to the faith of the blind man with compassion and think of ways that we can trust Jesus in situations of need.
