



Subject	Focus
English	Reading: Shakespeare – A Midsummer Night’s Dream SPaG: use a wide range of clause structures including subordinate clauses in different parts of the sentence. Speech to convey character and advance action Writing: diary entry, facts and opinions, tributes.
Mathematics	Maths investigations - finding patterns and solving problems in a systematic way and representing using algebra. Finding the ‘nth’ term in a sequence of numbers.
Science	Classification; families and inheritance; understanding DNA and how features such as eye colour are inherited. Studying finger prints and understanding human features that are different.
Computing	Select, use and combine a variety of software; photo stories/videos; E-safety; coding
Geography	Local community/where I live
Design Technology	Using tools; design; fashion and clothing. Design and make costumes and props for the leaver’s production.
Physical Education	Dance; end of year production
PSHE	Identity, personal views and opinions; my place; recognising strengths; transition to secondary school; first aid training
Music	Year 5/6 production
French	Building sentences, what is the time?
