Subject	Focus
English	<p>Reading: Oxford Reading Tree Phonics Programme: Letters and Sounds. The children are working on Phase 6 and revision of all spelling rules.</p> <p>Class Reading Book: The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch by Ronda Armitage; Sally and the Limpet by Simon Jones; The Snail and the Whale by Julia Donaldson.</p> <p>SPaG: compound sentences using 'and', 'or' and 'but'; using complex sentences using 'when', 'if', 'that' and 'because'.</p> <p>Writing: postcards, narrative and tongue twisters.</p>
Mathematics	<p>4 Operations: Solve problems with addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Use the language 'sum' and 'difference' e.g. three numbers sum to 12.</p> <p>Measurement: Compare and order lengths, masses, volume and record the results using <, > and = Solve simple problems in a practical context involving addition and subtraction of money of the same unit including giving change. Compare and sequence intervals of time. Tell and write the time to 5 minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times.</p> <p>Statistics: Interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables.</p>
Science	Plants: describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. Find out how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.
Computing	Search and watch film/live footage of seabirds in their natural habitats Introducing a common letter end and creating glue code using Logo
History	(Not during this term)
Geography	Coastal features; cliff, beach, erosion
Art and Design	Sketchbooks; 3D modelling; sand art; seascapes
Design Technology	Finger puppets
Physical Education	Dance: The Three Little Pigs Athletics: throwing, catching and jumping.
PSHE	Caring for the environment
Music	Exploring sound and making junk instruments. Songs in conjunction with topic.
