Subject	Focus
English	<p>Class reading book: The Hobbit (abridged version).</p> <p>Writing: Recount of trip to Box Hill and biography of a mountain climber.</p> <p>SPaG: Expanded noun phrase with preposition; fronted adverbial with comma; apostrophe for possessive 's' and plural 's'; use pronouns and nouns effectively; standard English verb forms; edit and proof reading.</p>
Mathematics	<p>Statistics: Interpret and present discrete and continuous data using bar charts and line graphs; solve comparison, sum and difference problems using information presented in bar charts, pictograms, tables and other graphs.</p> <p>Geometry: describe coordinates position on the 1st quadrant of a 2D grid; plot coordinate points and draw side to complete a polygon; describe translations (movements) between positions (left/right, up/down).</p>

Computing	Coding a 'Slug Trail' game using Scratch.

Geography	Magnificent mountains: to identify and locate mountain ranges on a map; to explore how mountains are formed; to identify the key features of a mountain range.
